## *Athletic Facilities*

### **J.M. STORZER CENTER (BASKETBALL, VOLLEYBALL, AND SWIMMING)**

Built in 1963, Wyman Gymnasium in J.M. Storzer Center houses Ripon men's and women's basketball and women's volleyball. In 2010, the court in Storzer Center was named "Bob Gillespie Court" in honor of longtime and current Ripon men's basketball coach Bob Gillespie and the floor now bears his name and signature. The Red Hawk nation can be seen cheering their teams on in this 1,000 seat gymnasium that has seen a total of 17 conference championships.

J.M. Storzer Center is also home to the Red Hawk's swimming pool, where the men's and women's swim teams compete. The pool features an NCAA regulation six-lane, 25 yard lane facility. It is equipped with one three-meter board and one one-meter board.

#### **DIRECTIONS TO STORZER CENTER:**

**From:** Green Bay Take Hwy 41 south to Oshkosh. Exit Hwy 44 (South Park Rd.) and turn right (west). Follow 44 west 18 miles into Ripon. Continue on 44, now Oshkosh Ave., for approx. two miles to stoplight at intersection with Hwy 23. Continue straight through stoplight, (Oshkosh Ave. has now turned into Union St.) for six blocks. Storzer parking lot is on right hand side.

**Approx. Travel Time:** 1 hr. 15 min.

**From:** Madison Take Hwy 151 north towards Fond du Lac. Exit CTH MMM north to Waupun. Continue three miles into Waupun on MMM to first stop sign at intersection with Hwy 49. Turn left or west on 49, and Ripon is 18 miles. Take first left in Ripon on Griswold St. Go two blocks to stop sign and turn right on Watson St. Go three blocks Down Watson St. and turn left on Thorne St. Continue on Thorne until intersection with Union. Storzer can be seen across Union St.

**Approx. Travel Time:** 1 hr. 15 minutes

**From:** Milwaukee/Chicago Take Hwy 41 north to Fond du Lac. Exit Hwy 23 (Johnson St.) and turn left (west). Follow 23 for 18 miles into Ripon. Continue on 23, now Fond du Lac Ave., for approx. one mile to the first stop sign. Left on Blackburn St. which curves right after 40 yards and turns into Thorne St. Take Thorne St. one mile, until it runs into Union. Storzer can be seen across Union St.

**Approx. Travel Time:** 1 hr. 40 min / 3 hours

**From:** Minneapolis/St. Paul Take Int 94 to Int 90/94. Continue on Int 90./94 to Hwy 82 in Mauston. Exit east or left on 82 and continue 20 miles to Int 51 where 82 ends and Hwy 23 begins. Continue on 23 east for 35 miles to Ripon. Stay on 23 for one mile in Ripon to second stop light. Turn right on

Union St and proceed six blocks to Storzer on right hand side.

**Approx. Travel Time:** 4 hr. 20 min.

## **Ingalls Field (Football, and Men's and Women's Track and Field)**

Ingalls Field is home to the Red Hawk football and track and field teams. The field, which was built in 1888, has a capacity of 3,500. It has seen many successful football teams and many memorable games, while also hosting the Midwest Conference track meet several times. In 2008, the field was renovated to add state-of-the-art artificial FieldTurf, replacing the former natural grass surface.

### **Directions to Ingalls Field:**

**From:** Green Bay Take Hwy 41 south to Oshkosh. Exit Hwy 44 (South Park Rd.) and turn right (west). Follow 44 west 18 miles into Ripon. Take first left in Ripon limits on Douglas St. and continue \_ mile to first stop sign. Turn right on Fond du Lac Ave. at stop sign and travel \_ mile to Ingalls Field on left side.

**Approx. Travel Time:** 1 hr. 15 min.

**From:** Madison Take Hwy 151 north towards Fond du Lac. Exit CTH MMM north to Waupun. Continue three miles into Waupun on MMM to first stop sign at intersection with Hwy 49. Turn left or west on 49, and then 18 miles to Ripon. Continue into town on 49, now Metomen St., and take fourth right on Belleville St. which leads to Ingalls Field one block away.

**Approx. Travel Time:** 1 hr. 15 minutes

**From:** Milwaukee/Chicago Take Hwy 41 north to Fond du Lac. Exit Hwy 23 (Johnson St.) and turn left (west). Follow Hwy 23 for 18 miles into Ripon. Continue on 23, now Fond du Lac Ave., for \_ mile and Ingalls Field will be on the left.

**Approx Travel Time:** 1 hr. 40 min / 3 hours

**From:** Minneapolis/St. Paul Take Int 94 to Int 90/94. Continue on 90/94 to Hwy 82 in Mauston. Exit east or left on 82 and continue 20 miles to Int 51 where 82 ends and Hwy 23 begins. Continue on 23 east for 35 miles to Ripon. Stay on 23 through Ripon to the east side of town. Ingalls Field is on the right, two blocks after Hwy joins Fond du Lac Ave.

**Approx. Travel Time:** 4 hr. 20 min.



## **Francis Field (Baseball)**

Francis Field is home to the Red Hawk baseball team, which has won 17 conference championships, including an amazing championship run in which they won the conference title in eight out of ten years from 1998-2007. The field was newly renovated in October of 2006, which included a new concession stand, new pressbox, brand new fencing around the field, and additional seating. The capacity at Francis Field is now approximately 350, with extra space to sit around the fence.

Francis Field is located to the South of Storzer Center. Parking is available in the parking lots in front and to the west of Storzer. The field can be accessed by walking around or through the building.



## **Tracy Field (Softball)**

Tracy Field is the friendly confines of the Ripon College softball team. There is plenty of seating available behind home plate, as well as around the fence. Tracy Field also saw some renovations in the Fall of 2006, with new fencing and landscaping, along with additional seating.

Tracy Field is located to the South of Storzer Center. Parking is available in the parking lots in front and to the west of Storzer. The field can be accessed by walking around or through the building.



## **Prairie Field (Men's and Women's Soccer)**

Prairie Field is the venue for Ripon College men's and women's soccer games. Prairie Field also received some renovations in 2006, getting a new sound system and press box.

Prairie Field is located to the South of Storzer Center, past Tracy Field, and on the other side of the football practice field. Parking is available in the parking lots in front and to the west of Storzer, as well as on the hill overlooking the field on Union Street.



## **Larson Courts (Men's and Women's Tennis)**

Larson Courts are home to the Red Hawk men's and women's tennis teams. Dedicated in 1996, the courts are named for the all-time winningest tennis coach in school history, the legendary Chuck Larson.

Larson Courts are located directly behind Storzer Center. There is plenty of parking available in the Storzer Center parking lots.

# How To Get To Ripon College

## By Car:

**From Chicago and points east or south:** Follow I-94N to Milwaukee. Follow 894 (bypass) around Milwaukee to Route 41/45. Follow 41N to Fond du Lac. Exit Route 23W (Johnson Street) to Ripon. In Ripon, 23 is Fond du Lac Street; take this to the intersection with Blackburn Street. Keep going straight ahead to stop sign (at Watson Street) and then straight ahead on Seward Street.

**From Green Bay and points north:** Follow Highway 41 south to Oshkosh. Exit Route 44 west to Ripon. In Ripon, turn left at the first four-way stop onto Eureka Street. Proceed through the traffic light where Eureka turns into Blackburn Street. At the four-way stop, turn right onto East Fond du Lac Street. At the next stop sign (Watson Street), go straight ahead on Seward Street.

**From Madison and points south or west:** Follow 151E toward Fond du Lac. Exit Highway 26N. In Waupun, turn onto Highway 49N through Brandon to Ripon. In

Ripon, turn left onto Fond du Lac Street. Proceed through the four-way stop to the next stop sign (Watson Street). Go straight ahead on Seward Street.

**From the Twin Cities and points west:** Follow I-94E. In Mauston, exit Route 82E, which turns into Route 23E at the junction with Route 51. Follow Route 23E to Ripon. In Ripon, go through two sets of stoplights and then turn right onto Elm Street, go up the hill and turn left onto Seward Street.

## By Plane:

Fly to the Outagamie County Airport in Appleton (40 miles away). Connecting flights can be made in Milwaukee, Chicago or the Twin Cities. Prospective students, please contact the Office of Admission and we'll arrange to pick you up when you arrive.

## By Bus:

Oshkosh is served by Greyhound. Prospective students, let us know when you arrive so we can arrange to pick you up.

# About Ripon College

## **Mission Statement**

Ripon College prepares students of diverse interests for lives of productive, socially responsible citizenship. Our liberal arts curriculum and residential campus create an intimate learning community in which students experience a richly personalized education.

Ripon College is a four-year, private, residential, liberal arts and sciences college located in Ripon, Wisconsin, a city of 7,600. Its 1,000 undergraduates represent 34 states and 14 countries. Equidistant from Milwaukee and Madison, Ripon is ideally located for internships and off-campus study.

A residential college, nine of 10 students live on campus where they participate in more than 70 campus organizations, 20 NCAA Division III sports and 14 intramural sports. The 250-acre campus has 25 buildings, several on the National Register of Historic Places.

Ripon is a true community of scholars where students and faculty work together for the success of all.

## **History & Mission**

Ripon College, founded in 1851, was converted from a college preparatory school to a four-year college in 1863. Its first class – four women: Luthera H. Adams, Harriet H. Brown, Susan A.W. Saulsbury and Mary F. Spencer – was graduated in 1867.

Today, Ripon's campus encompasses 250 tree-covered acres and includes 25 buildings. The original three limestone buildings which witnessed the commencement of 1867 remain in use: East, Smith and West Halls. These, along with seven other campus buildings, were added to the National Register of Historic Places in 1995.

A traditional college of the liberal arts, Ripon looks ahead without forgetting its distinguished past. College Days, which first appeared as a monthly literary magazine in 1868, is the oldest continually published college newspaper in Wisconsin. The Ripon football team first took the field against Lawrence University in 1893 (Ripon won 24-6) to begin what is believed to be the oldest football rivalry in the state. In 1911, Ripon College's debate team wrote the constitution for Pi Kappa Delta, now a national honorary society for debaters and orators. Its Hall of Fame is now located in East Hall's Kresge Little Theatre. The National Forensics League was founded at the College, where the

first national speech tournament for high school students was held in 1931.

In recognition of its academic excellence, the College was awarded a chapter of Phi Beta Kappa in 1953, placing it among a select group of the nation's top colleges. Ripon has had three Rhodes Scholars: Latimer Johns, class of 1911; Thomas Reinecke, class of 1968; and Zachary S. Morris, class of 2002.
