

Madison Area Technical College (Madison College) and Ripon College

Transfer Program

This agreement applies to students at Madison College who complete an associate in arts degree or associate in sciences degree in the liberal arts transfer program. Courses will be evaluated individually for students at Madison College who do not complete an associate in arts degree or associate in sciences degree in the liberal arts transfer program. Madison College students who are interested in transferring prior to their completion of an associate's degree should review the Ripon College transfer website for more information regarding requirements. 1. For students who have been awarded an associate in arts or associate in sciences in the Liberal Arts Transfer Program, at least 60 credits earned will transfer to Ripon College.
2. All Ripon College graduates must complete the 20 credit "Concentration in Applied Innovation," which meets all general education requirements. The 4 credit CTL 110 requirement is fulfilled by transfer credit. Two 4 credit seminars, CTL 220 and CTL 300, must be completed at Ripon College. The remaining two 4 credit seminars, CTL 120 and CTL 210, may be met by transfer based on Registrar's evaluation of particular courses.
3. Transfer credit may count toward completion of a Ripon College major; one-half the credits needed for a major must be earned in residence at Ripon College.

Transfer students who complete their associate in arts or associate in science degree from Madison College with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher who meet the following admission requirements will be granted admission to Ripon College and will matriculate with junior standing:

1. Have submitted an application complete with a transfer statement
2. Have provided an official High School transcript
3. Have submitted an official Madison College transcript. If a student is applying prior to the completion of their associate's degree at Madison College then Ripon College will accept an unofficial transcript until an official transcript with all earned credits is available.

Transfer Students entering the 2019-2020 academic year are eligible to earn annual merit based scholarships as detailed below.

Academic Scholarships and Awards:

3.85 to 4.0	Pickard Scholarship \$35,000/yr
3.70 to 3.84	Presidential Scholarship \$30,000/yr
3.55 to 3.69	Faculty Scholarship \$26,000/yr
3.40 to 3.54	Dean's Scholarship \$24,000/yr
3.00 to 3.39	Honor Scholarship \$22,000/yr
Below 3.00	Evans Award \$16,000/yr

Scholarships levels are subject to annual review and new scholarship offerings are subject to change. Current students may be eligible to apply for continuing student scholarships based on merit and involvement in the Ripon College community. Ripon College does provide need based aid to students

who are eligible and we encourage all students to consider using the resources available through the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). This agreement shall take effect March 15, 2019 and reviewed for extension every five years. Annually, courses excluded for transferability will be reviewed and updated.


Termination Conditions applying to both Madison College and Ripon College:




