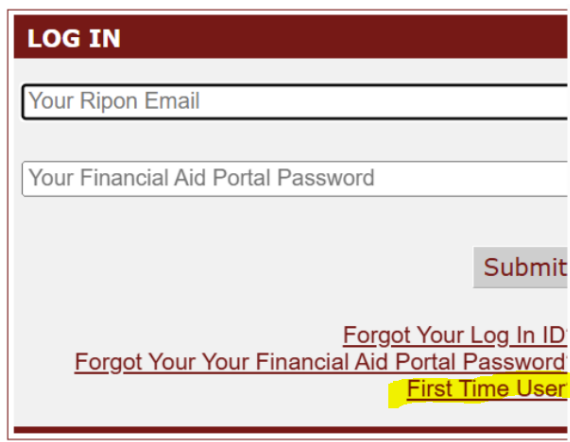


Financial Aid Portal

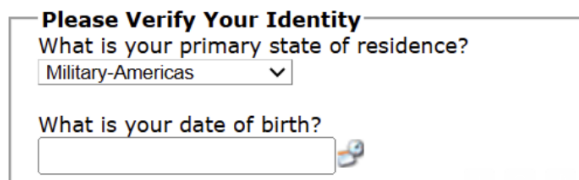

POLICIES AND PRACTICES GOVERNING STUDENT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

By accepting their aid on the student portal, the student agrees to comply with the following policies regarding financial aid.

1. The Financial Aid Office reserves the right on behalf of the College to review and cancel an award at any time program. If an overpayment occurs, the student is responsible for reimbursing the College.
2. Recipients of financial assistance from the College must notify the Financial Aid Office of any grants, scholarships, or other financial aid awards. In addition, any change in name, address, or student status should be reported.
3. Most financial aid awards are based on a student's financial need. Information that is reported on the Free Application for Student Aid (FAFSA). Financial aid awards are calculated based on the following equation: Cost of Attendance - SAI = Financial Aid. Financial aid awards are based on a student's financial need. 4. Financial aid is awarded contingent upon enrollment in an eligible program and maintaining satisfactory academic progress.
5. It is the policy of the College to disburse one-half of an award (excluding FWS) each semester.
6. Financial aid recipients are expected to enroll as full-time students in an eligible program. Enrollment status for each semester: Status is defined as full-time (12 or more hours), three-quarter time (9-11 hours), half-time (6-8 hours), or less than half-time (fewer than 6 hours). Financial aid awards are based on a student's financial need. Information that is reported on the Free Application for Student Aid (FAFSA). Financial aid awards are calculated based on the following equation: Cost of Attendance - SAI = Financial Aid.
7. Any commitment of Federal Funds is tentative and contingent upon subsequent Congressional appropriation and availability of funds.
8. New applications for financial aid are required and should be submitted as soon after October 1 (or when the
